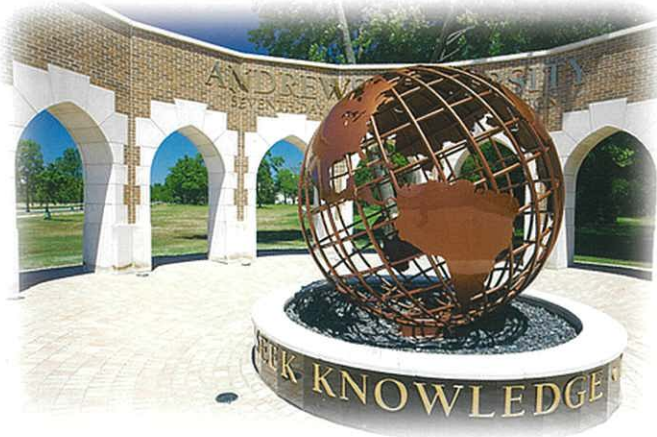

Bachelor of Science in Nursing (Registered Nurse)

Over the past several years policymakers, researchers and practice leaders have identified that education does make a difference in how a nurse practices.

Our baccalaureate nursing program provides students with a more in-depth study of the physical and social sciences, nursing research, nursing leadership and management, community and public health nursing, and the humanities; all within the context of a spiritual framework.

This broader education enhances the student's professional development and allows the baccalaureate graduate to better understand the many social, cultural, economic and political issues that impact patients and influence healthcare.



Aims and Objectives of the (2+3) Nursing Program

The program aims to :

- i) Provide students with a solid English Language and Health Science academic foundations.
- ii) Prepare students to obtain a Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing from Andrews University (AU).

Objectives of the program :

Through the completion of the first two years pre-nursing program at Hong Kong Campus (Hong Kong Adventist College), students will be able to use their English language competency and pre-nursing knowledge, so that they will be prepared to succeed in the degree nursing program at AU. Upon the completion of the pre-nursing program, students are expected to:

- i) Successfully pass the college level English language proficiency requirement;
- ii) Have acquired the foundational knowledge, skills and professional values for entering the Bachelor of Science in Nursing program at AU;
- iii) Achieve an accumulative GPA of 3.0 or above in all 4 semesters; and
- iv) Demonstrate critical and creative thinking for continuous professional training and lifelong learning.

Career Prospects

Graduates with a registered nurse license may practice in a variety of healthcare settings such as hospitals, outpatients clinics, schools, home healthcare services, and nursing care facilities. Those who want to advance their education or complete specialized training may obtain a master's degree in nursing to become a nurse practitioner, nurse anesthetist, nurse midwife, or clinical nurse specialist. Graduates may choose to pursue a master's or doctoral degree in nursing, education, public health, social science, health service management etc.

Minimum Admission Requirements:



1. Hong Kong Diploma in Secondary Education (HKDSE)

Level 3 in English and Chinese Language
Level 2 in Mathematics and Liberal Studies
Level 2 in an elective subject

2. 12-year High School Graduate

Overall GPA 2.50

3. Diploma in Pre-University Studies

Successful completion with a Graduating GPA of 2.25

4. Other equivalent internationally recognized examination result

Such as IB, ACT/SAT, GCE A-level

Students who do NOT meet the minimum requirements may be admitted provisionally or as guest students.

English Language Proficiency:

Students who score below Level 3 in English Language in Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education or Below IELTS 6.5/TOEFL IBT 80, are required to complete and pass the English Language Program.
